

Environmental Regulatory Information – WEEE & Waste Batteries

Below, you can read about our commitment to the WEEE (waste electrical and electronic equipment) Directive and how you can help us to preserve the environment.

Anetic Aid Ltd. and WEEE compliance:-

The powered functions of Anetic Aid's QA3 Patient Trolley (where applicable) and QA4 Surgery Trolley, along with the AET Electronic Tourniquet and AT4 Electronic and Pneumatic Tourniquet are subject to the WEEE directive and those marketed after 13th August 2005 comply with the WEEE requirements.



This symbol, applied on each unit, indicates that EEE (electrical and electronic equipment) waste must not be disposed of, as unsorted municipal waste and must be sorted separately.

End-of-life Devices:

WEEE Regulations place specific obligations on producers of non-household EEE when it reaches its end-of-life and is ready to be discarded as waste by non-household end users in the UK.

Producers have an obligation to non-household EEE to finance the costs of collection, treatment, recovery and environmentally sound disposal of the WEEE.

As regards the battery:

Do not throw out the battery belonging to the power supply unit as it contains substances and metals that are harmful to the environment.

As a producer of industrial batteries under the Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations 2009, we Anetic Aid Ltd. produce valve-regulated lead-acid, alkaline zinc-manganese dioxide, and nickel metal hydride batteries. We are obliged to take back free of charge, waste industrial batteries supplied to an end user for treatment and recycling. We are required to do this in any calendar year we place new industrial batteries on the market.

If any of our customers or in certain cases other end users, require us to take back WEEE and / or industrial batteries, they should contact us at the address below. We will agree the necessary arrangements for their return, proper treatment and recycling.

The decontamination of devices remains your responsibility.
